#### **Mathematics**

In our Maths lessons, we will be focus on the White Rose Maths mastery unit, Just Like Me!

We will explore counting and ordinal numbers and subitise small groups of objects.

We will match and sort a variety of materials, comparing size, amount, height, and length.

We will explore the natural environment, collecting objects, observing, printing and making our own repeating patterns.

We will discover symmetry, tessellation, and reflection through exploration of Rangoli patterns.

### **Physical Development**

In our PE lessons we will develop our core strength, balancing skills, and muscle tone through yoga and gymnastic activities.

We will be using our fine-motor skills as we start to write letters of the alphabet and use scissors to cut a variety of modelling materials.

#### Understanding the World

We will be talking about the weather and the seasonal change from autumn to winter.

We will learn about the traditional customs connected to the Hindu Festival of Light, Diwali.

#### **Expressive Art & Design**
