<u>Maths</u>

This term, we will be consolidating our knowledge and skills from all of KS2 and looking at how Maths can help us as we grow older. We will be exploring real life situations such as income, budgeting and bills. We will using maths skills such as perimeter, averages, and graphs to present data.

<u>Art</u> We will be using a range of mediums to create different props and backdrops for our end of year production!

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<u>English</u>

This term we will be looking at creative writing – planning, drafting, editing and publishing our own stories. We will focus on ensuring we have included detailed description and using a range of punctuation effectively. We will also be developing our reading, speaking and listening skills as we rehearse and perform our end of year play.

History and Geography

We start by looking at energy and sustainability – what people and civilisations need to survive and thrive, and how our energy needs are met. We will also learn about how the land use of our local area has changed over time. We will be developing our map and compass skills.

<u>PE</u>

This term, we will be looking at athletics and rounders. We will be improving our skills in a range of track and field events and working on batting and fielding techniques.

Computing

Children will be creating their own games in their computing lessons. They will design, create and debug their own unique games for others to play.

<u>PSHE</u>

We will learn about our bodies and minds, and how they change as we get older. We will look at different types of healthy relationships and how to keep ourselves safe and happy. We will also prepare for transition to secondary school!

Science

This term, our topic is electricity. We will look at famous scientists within this field including Edison and Latimer. We will also find out about the different symbols for electrical components in a circuit. We will design our own experiments to investigate an aspect of how electricity works, for example, what makes a bulb brighter in a circuit, and present our findings in different ways.
